## NOA Future Contact Lens Leader Scholarship

#### **Scholarship Program**

- 3) These competitive scholarships are available to up to three qualified optometry students who will be entering their third or fourth year of optometry school and current fourth year students who will enter a contact lens residency in July 2019.
